Pfizer Hospital is committed to ensuring high quality products for healthcare providers and their patients. As such, we would like to provide you with an update on National Drug Code (NDC) labeling of our products. We are continuing to implement changes to the way the NDC numbers are displayed on our injectable products to address evolving expectations.

Unit of Use NDC Updates

New **Unit of Use NDC** numbers have been assigned to **13** products since the last update in December 2019. Generally, this change is to the last two digits of the NDC, known as the package code, at the Unit of Use level, with the purpose of distinguishing between the Unit of Sale and the Unit of Use in the event these quantities differ.

- The product NDC is left unchanged and is also included in the product insert.
- The product NDC will continue to be the **Unit of Sale NDC** and is the NDC that should be used when ordering product.
- The **Unit of Use NDC** should be utilized for bedside scanning.

A list of the products with recently added **Unit of Use NDC** numbers is included at the end of this letter. Please note that this list only denotes the addition of Unit of Use NDC numbers and is not an indication of available supply.
